

Max Border Memorial Hot Shot Contest

John H. Bower Sunday School Basketball League players in the **Beginner, and Pee Wee** divisions are invited to participate in our annual Max E. Border Memorial Hot Shot Contest. It will be held:

9:30 - 1:30 [any time for either division]

Saturday January 22, 2011 at the YMCA Arena.

The Midget, Junior and Senior divisions have already participated in their Max E. Border Memorial [pre-season] Tip-off Tournaments.

Come as you are [either before or after your game as time permits]
advance registration is not required...bring your parent/coach to score your baskets
(There is no fee to participate.)

All participants will compete in the [**Beginner or Pee Wee**] division that they are currently playing in the league. There will be 3 medals awarded for each division to the top three finalists. Awards will be given out at the winners' next regularly scheduled game [January 29, 2011].

Hot Shot Basic Rules

Each participant will have one minute to score as many points as possible, shooting from designated spots on the floor.

Each basket made increases the score by appropriate value, only 2 lay-ups are allowed.

Must be standing on or behind shooting spot; both set shots and jump shots are allowed.

Participants must retrieve his/her own rebound without assistance from any spectators.

The ball must leave shooter's hand before time expires or basket doesn't count.

The winner of a tie will be determined by the participant who posts the greatest number of "5-point shots". If a tie still occurs, it will go to the greatest number of "4 point shots".

All scores are final.
